

Find out if you qualify for the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC)

Eligibility Guidelines

Earned income and adjusted gross income (AGI) must each be less than:

If filing...	Qualifying Children Claimed			
	Zero	One	Two	Three or more
Single, Head of Household or Widowed	\$14,820	\$39,131	\$44,454	\$47,747
Married Filing Jointly	\$20,330	\$44,651	\$49,974	\$53,267

Investment Income Limit

Investment income must be \$3,400 or less for the year.

Maximum Credit Amounts

The maximum amount of credit for Tax Year 2015 is:

- \$6,242 with three or more qualifying children
- \$5,548 with two qualifying children
- \$3,359 with one qualifying child
- \$503 with no qualifying children

Additionally, NJ State EITC is 30% of your Federal Credit.
